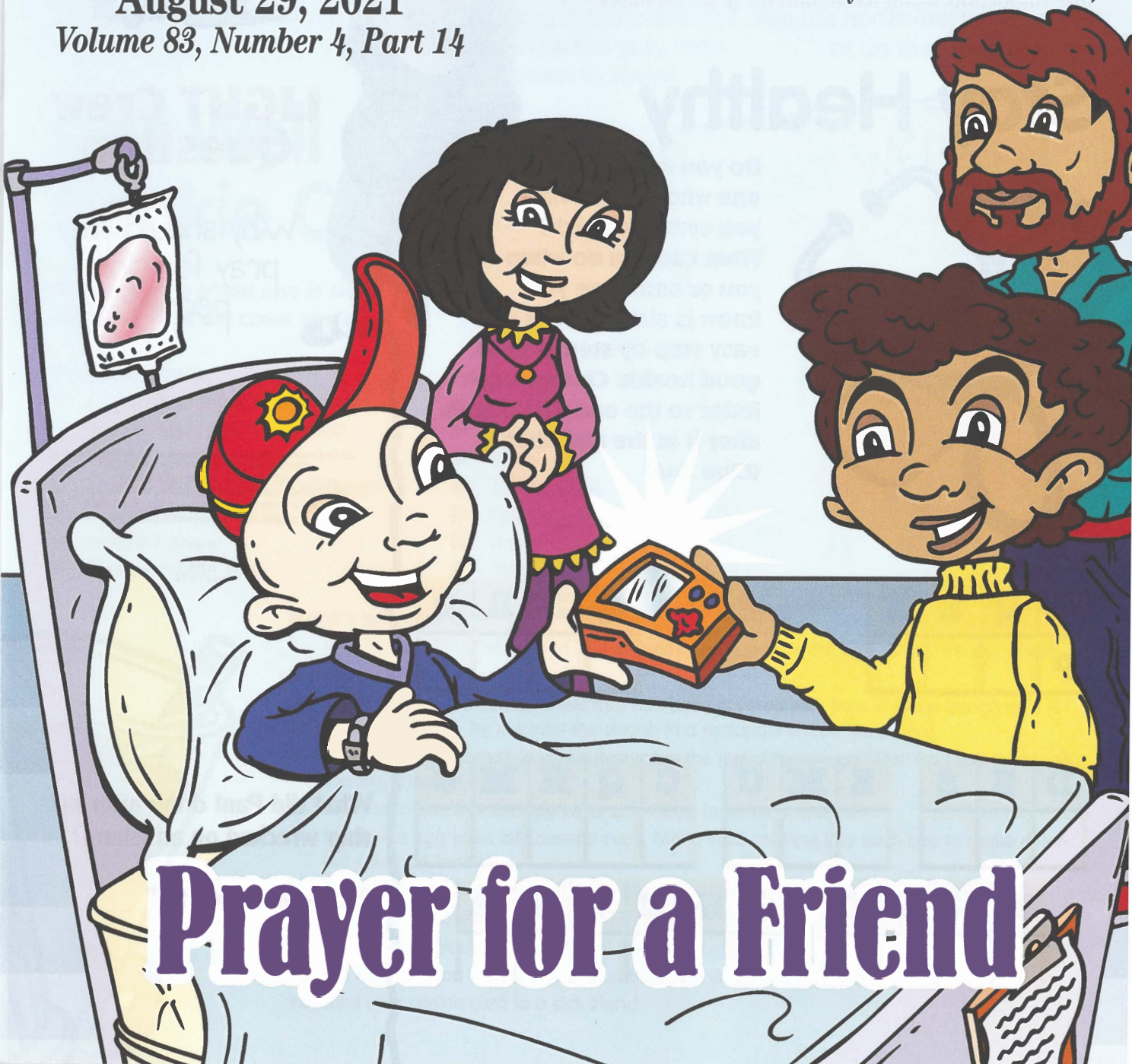
David peeked around the corner and smiled. Li smiled back. David held out the game. "Do you like it?" he asked.

David's dad smiled. "We will pray that God makes you feel hungry," he said. So they prayed for Li. Then they left so Li could rest.

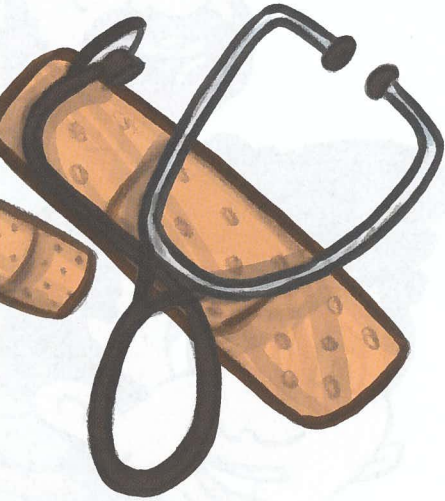
After school the next day Li called. "David, I ate all my breakfast and all my lunch. It tasted so good. Thanks for praying. The doctor said I can go home soon."

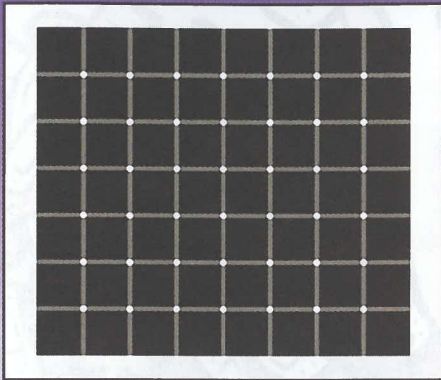

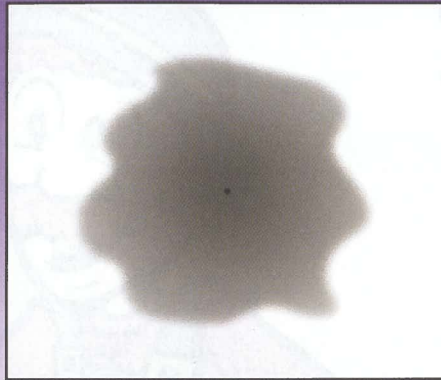


Look Again

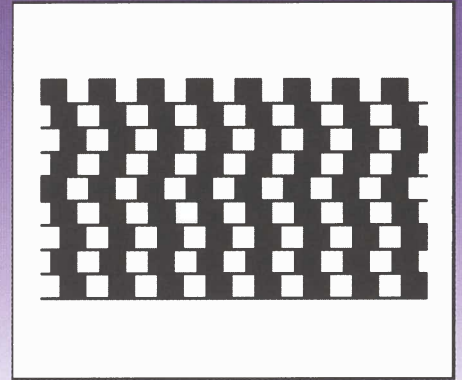
Look at these pictures that fool your eyes. Who made your eyes?

Get Well Cookie Card

Do you have a friend who is sick?
This tasty card will cheer him up.

You will need:

- Refrigerated sugar cookie dough
- 2 eggs, separated by an adult
- Cookie cutter shapes
- Small, clean watercolor paintbrush
- 1/2 teaspoon of water
- Several cups
- Plastic or paper plate
- An adult
- All purpose flour
- Rolling pin
- Cookie sheet
- Food colors
- A fork
- Plastic wrap



Here's what to do:

1. Let the adult turn the oven to 350 degrees and separate the egg yolks from the whites
2. Unwrap the cookie dough.
3. Place dough on a cookie sheet that has been covered with flour. Roll the dough so it is about 1/4" thick. Try to make the dough in a rectangle shape like a card.
4. Use the cookie cutters to make designs in the top of the dough. (Don't cut the dough all the way through.)
5. Use the fork to mix the egg yolks and water together in a bowl.
6. Divide the egg yolks into several cups. Mix a food coloring into each cup to make different colors of "paint."
7. "Paint" the designs with the brush. Clean your brush when you change colors.
8. The adult will bake the cookie for 17 or 18 minutes. It will be golden brown.
9. Let an adult take the cookie out of the oven. Let it cool.
10. Put your card on the plate. Cover with plastic wrap and add a bow.
11. Take your cookie card to a sick friend.



Handy-Dandy Bandages

Have you ever had a cut? Did you use a Band-Aid to keep it clean? Now Band-Aids come in many shapes and colors. But who made the first Band-Aids? Read here to find out.

In 1920, Earle Dickson's wife was learning to cook. She often cut or burned herself. Then Earle would bandage her.

Earle worked for a company that made tape and gauze. Earle wanted to find a better way to take care of his wife's "owies." He thought and thought. Then he had a great idea. He would make tape-and-gauze strips ahead of time.

The next time his wife cut herself, she used one of Earle's inventions. She peeled the ready-made bandage and put it on her wound.

Earle showed his ready-made bandages to his bosses at work. They liked it. And that's where "Band-Aids" came from.
